Stirling MP Alyn Smith has offered comment on the recent update from First Minister Nicola Sturgeon, regarding Scotland's fight against Covid-19. Stirling, along with 12 other mainland local authorities, is set to remain in Level 2 to safeguard progress in suppressing the virus.

[Stirling Politicians Back Drug Law Reform](#)

Alyn Smith MP and Evelyn Tweed MSP have expressed support for the all-party campaign to reform drugs law – including decriminalisation – and have renewed calls for immediate action on drug consumption rooms. The Misuse of Drugs Act (1971) was designed to prevent drug

use and reduce harm but since it came into effect there has been a dramatic rise in drug use, addiction and deaths in the UK.

Stirling MP Alyn Smith has expressed his support for Stirling's industry-leading dairy sector, as businesses begin to see the green shoots of economic recovery from the pandemic.
