That's a COP - Progress Made on Climate

Glasgow played host to the UK's largest ever summit between the 1st - 12th November as thousands of delegates from around the world gathered to keep "1.5 alive" and prevent rampant climate change. The SNP were highly active, with First Minister Nicola Sturgeon meeting with the likes of President Biden and Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez, as well as climate activists Vanessa Nakate and Greta Thunberg.

Alyn Smith and Stewart McDonald were also present at COP26 with Alyn meeting with representatives of the Kurdish People's Democratic Party and Stewart being a key speaker at Taiwan's COP26 Day.

SNP Foreign Affairs spokesperson Alyn Smith met with Mark Clifford and other representatives of the Committee for Freedom on Hong Kong (CFHK) in London in November.

Bosnia on Edge of Disastrous Conflict

Tensions in Bosnia and Herzegovina have risen dramatically in recent months as Serb nationalists, led by Milorad Dodik, push to secede from the fragile state with no regard to the consequences of their actions.

SNP Defence Spokesperson Stewart McDonald will be co-leading a debate in the House of Commons in December. Meanwhile, writing in The National, Alyn outlined the causes of the recent tension and warned that without "decisive action... history is doomed to repeat itself."

#EscapeTheScan - A Global Campaign to Ban Killer Robots

SNP MP Alyn Smith joined Amnesty International and Stop Killer Robots UK at the launch of their new campaign #EscapeTheScan.

The campaign uses a filter on Instagram which simulates an encounter where you need to escape a Lethal Autonomous Weapons Systems (LAWS).

It hopes to raise awareness of the dangers of LAWS and push for a global ban on these dangerous weapons, a measure which the SNP fully supports.

Still Hostage - Parliamentarians Call for Nazanin's Freedom

SNP MPs engaged in cross-party solidarity in a packed Westminster Hall as they called for the release of Nazanin Zaghari-Ratcliffe and other UK hostages of Iran. They were joined by her husband, Richard, who had completed a 21-day hunger strike outside the FCDO.

SNP Foreign Affairs spokesperson Alyn Smith called on the Government to explore alternative means of paying the UK's debt and for Magnitsky sanctions to be used against individuals of the Iranian regime responsible for her continued incarceration in Iran.
